French firm Valeo to pump in €200 m by 2028

FUTURE BETS. Investment to deepen localisation and strengthen next-gen automotive tech, besides expanding Indian footprint

New Delhi

French auto technology provider Valeo on Wednesday said it plans to invest more than €200 million in the next two years (around ₹2,149.20 crore, subject to prevailing exchange rates), to significantly expand its industrial footprint in India.

The investment will enable Valeo to triple its sales in India to around €700 million by 2028, and will also help prepare for the next step of high growth beyond 2028, a top official of the company told reporters here.

“The pace of transformation in the Indian automotive sector is remarkable, driven by a strong focus on electrification, autonomous driving, and sustainable mobility. As India and France deepen their strategic partnership, Valeo continues investments in localisation, research and development (R&D), and advanced manufacturing to support India’s ambition to become a global hub for next-generation automotive technologies,” Christophe Périllat, CEO of Valeo, said here.

Périllat is part of the French delegation that has come with President Em-

manuel Macron to attend the India AI Impact Summit, and also various bilateral trade agreements between the two countries during this visit.

He said the group was leveraging the rapid acceleration of electrification and artificial intelligence (AI) technologies to serve the growing needs of both Indian and global original equipment manufacturers (OEMs).

INDIA STRATEGY

Valeo’s strategy is focused on building strong competencies in new technology products in India, while progressively increasing localisation across manufacturing and operations.

The company has commissioned a new plant and dedicated e-axle production lines at its Pune facility to support a major electrification programme with Mahindra & Mahindra.

Valeo has been selected to supply electric powertrains for a range of vehicles under M&M’s ‘Born Electric’ passenger vehicle platform, along with on-board charger combo units for its electric utility vehicles.

This strategic partnership represents a total order value close to \$1 billion and reinforces Valeo’s commitment to localisation and the growth of India’s electric mobility ecosystem, he added.

FedEx to invest ₹2,500 cr in Navi Mumbai cargo hub

FedEx will invest ₹2,500 crore in developing an air cargo hub at Navi Mumbai airport to support India’s trade and transshipment ambitions.

The hub will comprise a fully automated facility over 3 lakh sq ft, with dedicated freighter parking bays.

Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis performed a ground breaking ceremony along with the senior leadership of FedEx and Adani Airports on Wednesday.

The facility will be operational in two years and will result in direct and indirect employment of 6,000 persons.

“India’s trade ambition is entering a new phase — moving beyond point-to-point volume flows towards hub-led transshipment-driven logistics. FedEx Navi Mumbai hub is designed to support this shift,” said Raj Subramaniam, President and CEO, FedEx. The world’s largest express transport company has air cargo hubs in Guangzhou (China) and Dubai.

FedEx operates 24 weekly freighter flights to Delhi, Mumbai and Bengaluru. Jeet Adani, Director, Adani Airport Holdings Ltd, said the FedEx investment is a statement of confidence in India’s growth trajectory.

“For SMEs, manufacturers and agricultural exporters, the hub will serve as a bridge to the rest of the world,” he added.

“At a time when global trade and supply chains are rapidly evolving, FedEx’s decision to establish a major hub in Mumbai reflects India’s rising global economic strength and Maharashtra’s strategic importance in international commerce,” Fadanvis said.

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Modi discusses gains from India-EU FTA with leaders from Finland, Spain

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday highlighted the boost to India-EU economic ties from the India-EU free trade agreement (FTA) during meetings with the leaders of Finland and Spain on the sidelines of the India AI Impact Summit in New Delhi.

The PM welcomed several world leaders, including UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres, IMF chief Kristalina Georgieva, Sri Lanka President Anura Kumara Dissanayake, Bhutan PM Tshering Tobgay, Mauritius PM Navinchandra Ramgoolam, Croatia PM Andrej Plenkovic, Serbia President Aleksandar Vucic, Seychelles Vice-President Sebastien Pillay, Estonia President Alar Karis, Greece Prime Minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis at the ongoing AI Impact Summit on Wednesday.

Over 20 Heads of State, 60 Ministers and 500 global AI leaders are participating in the AI Impact Summit 2026, in New Delhi, according to the government.

“Held extensive discussions with the Prime Minister of Finland, Petteri Orpo. Thanked him for his personal support to the India-EU FTA, which ushers in a golden era in India-Europe relations,” Modi said on X.

India and Finland aim to double bilateral trade,

strengthening economic linkages, he said. “We also talked about enhancing co-operation in futuristic technologies like 6G, innovation, clean energy, biofuels, circular economy and more,” the PM added.

In a separate meeting with Spanish President Pedro Sánchez, the two leaders discussed the FTA’s positive impact on the India-Spain economic partnership.

POSITIVE IMPACT

“The historic FTA with the EU will have a very positive impact on the economic partnership with Spain and provide new opportunities to the people of our nations,” Modi noted.

The Prime Minister said talks also covered defence, security and technology. “Our nations are marking 2026 as the India-Spain year of culture, tourism and AI. This will deepen people-to-people linkages. Glad to see a

big delegation of universities also come to India. This too will go a long way in connecting our people,” the PM said.

BILATERAL TALKS

Modi also held bilateral discussions with Serbian President Aleksandar Vucic. Serbia is a candidate for EU accession.

Modi expressed confidence that the ties would gather momentum. “We discussed ways to deepen co-operation in areas such as defence, manufacturing, DPI, fertilizers and infrastructure. For many years, India and Serbia have worked closely and I am confident our ties will gain even more momentum in the times to come,” he posted on X.

Negotiations on the India-EU FTA concluded last month. The pact is undergoing legal scrubbing and translation and will take effect after endorsement by the European Parliament.

India, UK launch offshore wind task force

India and the UK on Wednesday announced the launch of the India-UK Offshore Wind Taskforce, which aims to offer strategic leadership to develop related ecosystems.

Pralhad Joshi, Minister of New & Renewable Energy, said, “In the ongoing financial year, we added more than 35 gigawatt (GW) of solar and 4.61 GW of wind capacity. Also, last year India achieved 50 per cent of its cumulative installed power capacity from non-fossil sources. Five years ahead of our national nationally determined contribution commitment...”

Offshore wind energy plays a strategic role in the next phase of India’s clean energy transition with the government identifying promising zones off the coast of Gujarat and Tamil Nadu, he noted.

As agreed under the India-UK Vision 2035 and the Fourth Energy Dialogue, the taskforce has been constituted to provide strategic leadership and coordination for India’s offshore wind ecosystem.

While the UK has demonstrated global leadership in scaling offshore wind, from early-stage deployment to large commercial markets with mature supply chains, India adds scale, long-term demand and a rapidly growing clean energy ecosystem, he noted.

Three teenage students end lives at different places in Chhattisgarh's Korba in single day
KORBA: In separate incidents, three students, two of them girls, allegedly committed suicide in Korba district of Chhattisgarh on Wednesday, police said. Each teenage victim studied in Class 9, 10 and 12, they said, adding that the reasons behind their extreme step are yet to be identified. In the first case, Anjali Kewat (17), a Class 10 student of a private school in Indiranagar area under Kotwali police station limits, hanged herself at her home, a police official said. After being informed by her family, a police team registered a case in this connection and launched an investigation, he said. In another incident, Geeta Mahant (15), a Class 9 student from Dhamnaguri village under Uрга police station, hanged herself to death from a tree, the official added. In the third case, Ujjwal Dansena alias Dhruv (17), who studied in Class 12 and resided in ITI Basti under Civil Lines police station limits, hanged himself from a ceiling fan at his home, according to him.

Branded witch, woman set on fire with one-year-old baby in arms at Jharkhand
CHAIBASA: A 32-year-old woman and her baby were allegedly set on fire in Jharkhand's West Singhbhum district after she was branded a witch, police said on Wednesday. The incident happened at a village in the Kumarjung police station area late on Tuesday, and four people have been arrested, they said. The woman's husband was also injured in the attack, but he managed to escape. He spent the night at a relative's place and reached the police station on Wednesday morning. In his complaint, he alleged that he woke up in the middle of the night after hearing that some people were calling him and his wife. When he went out, he saw that around a dozen people had gathered, accusing his wife of practising witchcraft. Amid the commotion, the mob poured kerosene on his wife, who had their one-year-old baby in her arms, and set them on fire, according to the complaint. They died on the spot, police said.

Bomb threat triggers evacuation at Jaipur college
JAIPUR: A bomb threat email received by Swami Keshvanand Institute of Technology, Management and Gramothan (SKIT) in Jagatpura area here on Wednesday morning triggered panic, prompting authorities to evacuate the campus, police said. Police teams, the fire brigade and the bomb disposal squad rushed to the spot and conducted an extensive search of the premises till noon. No suspicious objects have been found so far, they said. Police added that prima facie, it appears to be a hoax, as similar emails have been sent to educational institutions in the past. The email received at around 6.15 am by the principal claimed that RDX-based explosive devices had been planted in the college, warning of a blast at 11.45 am.

Massive blaze guts textile showroom in Kozhikode, loss pegged at Rs 50 crore
KOZHIKODE: Goods worth Rs 50 crore were destroyed in a major fire that gutted a textile showroom near the Kozhikode railway station, police said on Wednesday. The blaze broke out at the Jayalaxmi Silks showroom on Tuesday evening and was brought under control after several hours of firefighting by multiple fire tenders. According to a complaint filed by the establishment, the fire caused losses estimated at Rs 50 crore. Showroom owner Govind Kamat said the loss was three times higher than that incurred in a fire in 2023. On April 1, 2023, a blaze had broken out on the third floor of the building. "At that time, only one floor was damaged. This time, two floors were affected," he said.

Two minors raped in Jharkhand, one person arrested
GUMLA/DUMKA (JHARKHAND): Two girls have been allegedly raped in separate incidents in Jharkhand's Gumla and Dumka districts, police said on Wednesday. One person has been arrested in connection with one of the cases. A 15-year-old girl was allegedly raped by a man while she was returning to her hostel from school in Raidih area of Gumla district on Monday, a police officer said. A case under sections of the BNS and POCSO Act was registered, he added. In another incident, a teenage girl was raped in Jarmundi area in Dumka district while returning from Basukinath fair on Monday.

Hoax emails spark bomb scare at two Telangana courts
HYDERABAD: Panic gripped two court complexes in Telangana on Wednesday after separate bomb threats triggered security alerts, police said. The CBI court in Hyderabad's Nampally received an email claiming that RDX IEDs had been planted in the judge's chamber and court premises and would detonate when individuals carrying remote controls approached the office. Bomb detection and disposal teams were deployed, and a thorough search was conducted before officials declared the threat a hoax.

Can't say when I'll return to India; legally barred from leaving UK: Mallya to Bombay HC

PTI, MUMBAI: Fugitive businessman Vijay Mallya, facing multiple cases of fraud and money laundering, told the Bombay High Court on Wednesday that he cannot say when he will return to India as he is legally barred from leaving the UK. In a statement submitted through his counsel Amit Desai to the high court, Mallya said he did not have an active passport after it was revoked and hence, he cannot give a definite date of return to India. The statement was submitted after a bench of Chief Justice Shree Chandrashekar and Justice Gautam Ankhad made it clear last week that it would not hear Mallya's plea against the order declaring a fugitive economic offender until he returns to India. The court had then asked



the former liquor to clarify whether or not he intended to return to India. Mallya, based in the United Kingdom since 2016, has filed two petitions in the HC -- one challenging an order declaring him a fugitive economic offender and the other questioning the constitutional validity of the Fugitive Economic Offenders Act. The 70-year-old liquor baron is accused of defaulting on multiple loan repayments of several thousand crores and facing money laundering charges. The businessman, in

his statement to HC, said he cannot give a definite date for his return as he does not have his Indian passport, which was revoked by the government in 2016, and also because there are orders of courts in England and Wales that prohibit him from leaving the country. "Mallya is not permitted to leave or attempt to leave England and Wales or apply for or be in possession of any international travel document. In any event, the petitioner is unable to precisely state when he will return to India," Desai read out the statement in the court. The senior counsel reiterated that Mallya's presence was not required in the country for the court to hear his pleas against the fugitive tag and the provisions of the Act.

Congress to launch protests over farmer distress, jobs, women's safety: Chennithala

PTI, MUMBAI: The Congress said on Wednesday it will soon launch protests across Maharashtra over farmers' distress, jobs, and women's safety, accusing the BJP of playing politics in the name of development. Addressing reporters after a party meeting, the Congress' Mahar-

ashtra-in-charge Ramesh Chennithala said they would focus on strengthening the organisation in the coming year by making appointments up to the village level

and reinforcing its various units. He alleged that the BJP governments at the Centre and in the state were indulging in politics in the name of development.
